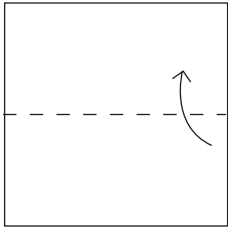


BIRD OF PARADISE NAPKIN FOLDING



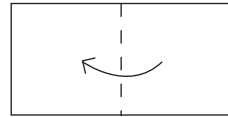

Start with square Chinet® Dinner Napkin completely unfolded. Fold in half.

forming a long rectangle



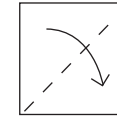

Fold the napkin in half again,



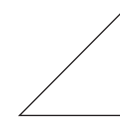

now forming a square.



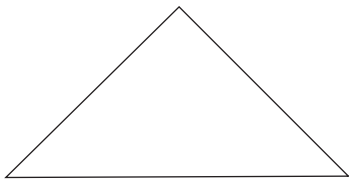

Fold the napkin in half diagonally,



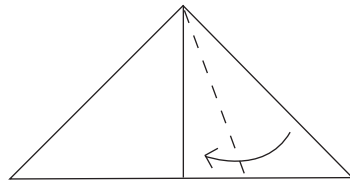

creating a triangle.



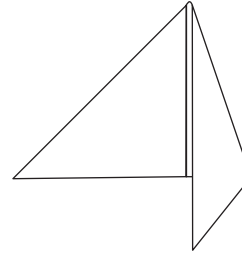

Orient the triangle so the open tip is facing away from you.



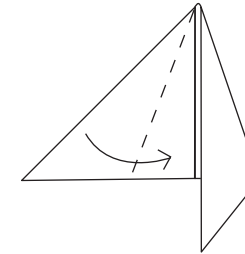

Fold the right corner diagonally towards you - laying it down along the centerline of the triangle,



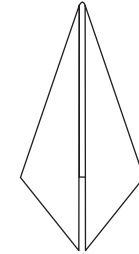

making a new tip pointing towards you.



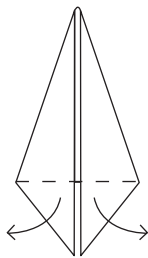

Do the same with the left corner, fold it diagonally toward you and press it down next to the previous fold.



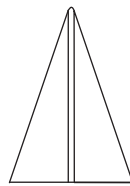

Now you have a diamond.



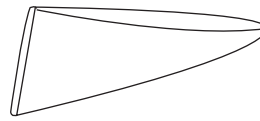

Fold the two "wings" under



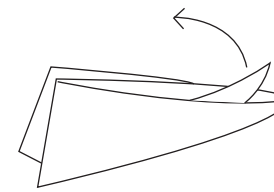

so that you have your original triangle shape back.



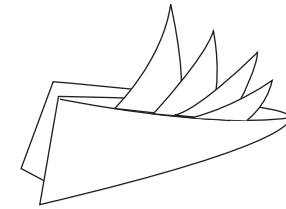

Fold the napkin back in half, away from you. This is what it should look like from the side.

To make the feathers hold the base firmly to keep your folds together.

Pull up the four 'flaps' created by the napkin's corners.
